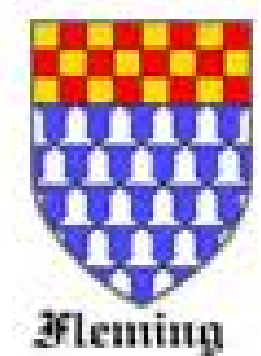

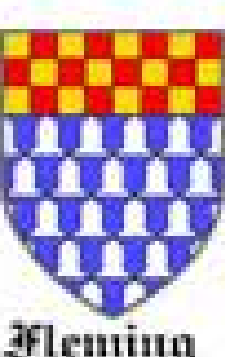

County Cess paid by gneves^e which in this Td. is estimated to be 8 and is generally from £1. to ~~xxxx~~ £1. 2s. 1¹/₂d. per half yearly.

Glebe of Farran -- B.S.; M.J.O'D. 9

Situated in the Centre of the Northern part of the Ph. and is bounded N. by the Townland of Kilcow; W. by the Townland of Lissheenbaun; S. and E. by the Townland of Farran.

This Townland contains ---- acres all arable land. Limestone nature; one third tilled. There is an old in ruins in the N. end, to which is a Burial Ground attached, called Dysart Church. The Mail Car road from Castle Island to Killarney runs through the Centre of this Td.

fourth This Townland contains ---- acres, all arable land; one fourth tilled; Limestone burned and used for manure; the proprietor Arthur Lloyd Sanders Esqr. has it let to 4 Tenants at will for £145 by bulk. There is a Danish Fort in the Centre of this Td. called Farran Fort; County Cess generally at 1s. to the Pound since the Applotment of 1836.

The Proprietor Maurice Brennan Esqr. has it let to 16 Tenants in unequal portions by bulk and at will. County Cess paid by Gneeves and is estimated in this Td. to be six and pays from £1. to £1. 2s. 1d. per half yearly. There are 3 Danish Forts in this Td. viz. Lissavoher, Lissnascoube & Lissheenasdonogha.

Situated in the N.W. extreme point of the Northern part of the Ph. and is bounded N. by the Parishes of Mohaval and Castle Island; W. by the Parish of Killeenteerna; S. by the Townlands of Cleonahurrig and Lissheenbaun & E. by Clashganniv.

This townland contains ---- acres of arable land and ---- acres of Bog. There is but a small of this Td. tilled; the quality is good; the Proprietor Henry A. Herbert Esqr. has part let to Tenants on a lease of one life and in Portions by bulk for £280 yearly rent and the other part at will and from £2. to £2. 5s. per acre. Lissanerrig is in the E. end

Situated in the Northern side of the Td. of Lisheenbaun, on the W. side at the Meeting of the 3 roads. This is a remarkable Danish Fort from which the Townland of Lisheenbaun derives its name. There is another large Danish Fort a few chains W. of it.

Situated in the Western side of the Td. of Dicksgrove. This House the residence of Captain Meridith is beautifully shaded with large Trees of Ash and Elm &c. It is a handsome House 3 story high.

Kilsarkan Church (49)

Situated in the N.W. end of the Td. of Kilsarkan East.

This is a very ancient church; the E. end and part of the side walls are still standing and covered with ivy. There is a very spacious burial ground attached to it and enclosed by a w. S. wall. There are four splendid tombs, one of which has the following Inscription for the O'Connor Family:-

Three warlike Lions with their bloody swords in hand,
Crisscross the Griffen the Lizard doth stand

The Royal Oak with all his flourishing charms
 Stands for the Princely O'Connors coat of arms.

Situated in the N.E. end of the Td. of Glaunleigh.
 These are two handsome Danish Fort, like two circles touching
 one another and are called in common by the Inhabitants Glaun-
 leigh Fort.
