

The Fleming Family – Descendants of Michael of Blarney, who came to live in the Parish of Kilcummin.

In the year of 1775 a Mr. Fleming lived in Blarney, Co.Cork, and kept a sort of Hostel for the accommodation of Kerry people who then were accustomed to cart butter from Kerry to the Cork Butter Market. This Fleming man had a son Michael and a McCarthy from Currow Parish took a fancy to him and brought him home with him to Currow and got him married to his only daughter. (This Mr. Fleming of Blarney, according to tradition in the family said that his family of Flemings came from Coolick in the Parish of Kilcummin near Killarney).

MICHAEL FLEMING and his wife McCARTHY had issue: MICHAEL, JAMES, JOHN, DAVID, TOM AND GARRET. (David, Tom and Garret never came to live in Kilcummin)

A(i) MICHAEL M. FLEMING came as a cl. isteach to Inch and married a girl named KELLY. (They lived at Inch House the present residence of Patrick P. Fleming) issue: three sons and three daughters all of whom went to America except

A(ii) Mary who married, in one-third of her father's farm, a Corney O'Leary of Milleen. Corney and Mary Fleming were evicted from their Inch portion of land and they came to live to Milleen and got one third of his father's farm there. They had issue:

A(iii) John, Pat, Mike and nine daughters all of whom went to America except John who married Kate O'Sullivan of Tournaneagh. Issue:

A(iv) Kate, Bridget, Julia, Mary, Con and Jeremiah.  
Kate O'Leary went to America. She is housekeeper to Fr. Eugene Teahan of Kansas City, U.S.A.

Bridget O'Leary m. John O'Riordan, a motor mechanic in Killarney.  
They have issue all young.

Julia O'Leary went to America.

Mary O'Leary is at home unmarried.

Con O'Leary married Mary McCarthy of Lyreatane in 1936 in family farm.

Jeremiah O'Leary m. Mary Teahan of Knockacullig. They have two farms one Kilbrowne and the other, a large one, at Rathanane. Issue :

A(v) Kathy, Jer, John, Pat, Con, Christie, Bridget, Mary and Julia.  
All young and unm.

Tom James Fleming m. in his f.f. Nora O'Keeffe of Tureen, Co. Cork.

B(v) Issue: Pat, Jack, Jim and Margaret. All home and unkm.

Julia James Fleming m. Ned Counihan of Faha, Beaufort.

B(v) Issue: John, Ned, Abbie and Mary.

John Fleming Counihan lives in a labourer's cottage in his f.f. and works around as a tradesman

Ned Fleming Counihan m. in his f.f. Ellie Barry of Anabla. Issue: B(vi) Two boys and two girls

Abbie Fleming Counihan m. Michael Quirke who was shop-keeper in Miltown. They have issue.

Mary Fleming Counihan m. \_\_\_\_\_ of Milltown. They have an extensive business concern and have but one child B(vi) Margaret.

John John Fleming never m. and lives at his Toremore farm which he gave to his nephew - John Michael Fleming.

Michael John Fleming m. in his f.f. Kate Doolin of Ballydwyer, Ballymacelligott. Issue: B(iv) John, James, Tom, Julia, and Hannah.

John Michael Fleming m., in his uncle's (Tim's) farm at Toremore, a Mary Lynch of Annaghilmore. Issue: B(v) Michael, Con, Hannah and Sheila.

Michael is a Chemist's Assistant in Killarney and now a political prisoner in England

Sheila is a nurse in England.

Con and Hannah at home unkm. In 1936.

James Michael Fleming is married in ½ his F.F. at Inch to Ellen Cronin of Knockachorrin. Issue: B(v) Michael, John, Catherine, Julia and Margaret.

John and Margaret are at home unkm.

Julia is a Nun in Kilkenny and

Catherine is m. in America.



*Tom Michael Fleming, M.C.C. is m., in ½ his f.f. at Inch, to Kathleen Kelly of Tournanonagh. Issue: B(v) Michael, Pat, Tom, Dan, Kate, Janie and Sheila. Michael and Tom are Christian Brothers.*

*Sheila is a Nun.*

*Janie is working in England.*

*The rest are at home unmarried (1936)*

*Julia Michael Fleming m. Tom Murphy of Milltown. She was his second wife and died without issue.*

*Hannah Michael Fleming is unmarried.*

*Pat John Fleming died unmarried in America.*

*Mary John Fleming m. John Daly of Dooneen. Issue B(v) John, William, Batt, James, Michael, Nora, Julia, Hannah, Nellie and Minnie.*

*John Daly went to America. He m. and has B(vi) a son a Priest. William Daly died when young.*

*Batt Daly went to America where he m. He is dead.*

*James Daly m. in his f.f., Nellie Courtney of Tomies. Issue: B(v) Sean and Paddy.*

*Michael Daly is in Chicago Police Force. He is m. to Julia Fleming of Inch and they have B (v) issue.*

*Nora Daly m. Denis Reidy of Clogher. Issue dead.*

*Julia Daly is m. in America and has 5(v) issue.*

*Hannah Daly is married in America and has issue.*

*Nellie Daly died when young.*

*Minnie Daly is m. to David D. Healy of Clashnagarrane. Issue: B(v) David.*

*Ellen John Fleming m. Murty Buckley of Faha. Issue: B(iv) John, Larry, Pat, Micheal, Murty, Jim, Jeremiah, Mary Ellie, Nora and Julia (11).*

*John Buckley is ex R.I.C. and unmarried.*

*Larry Buckley m., in of his father's farms, a Lyne of Ballymalis – a sister of a Father Lyne at one time a Curate in Currow Parish. They have B(v) six or seven in family. All young.*

*Pat Buckley* is m. near Millstreet to *Pat Kearney's* daughter of *Ballincarrig*. They have B(v) issue.

*Michael Buckley* is m. in his f.f. at *Keal Faha*, to *Sis Prendergast* of *Cahirdean, Ballyhar*. They have B(v) a large young family.

*Murty Buckley* is m. in America.

*Jim Buckley* is unm. And lives with his brother *Larry* at *Faha*.

*Jeremiah Buckley* has a farm at *Rockfield* and was unm. in 1938.

*Mary Buckley* is m. to *Richard Shanahan* of *Castleisland*. Have B(v) issue.

*Ellie Buckley* is m. to *John O'Riordan* of *Listry*, a farmer. They have B(v) five or Six in family.

*Nora Buckley* is m. to a *Mr. Scollard* of *Ballybeggan* near *Tralee*. They too have B(v) five or six in family.

*Julia Buckley* is m. in America.

Nano John Fleming m. *Tim Kerin* of *Gortglass*. Issue:  
B(iv) *John Con, Humphrey, Tim Bridget, Jim, Mary and Julia* (8)

*John Kerin* is a Customs & Excise Officer in *Cork*. unm.

*Con Kerin* is working in *Cork*. unm.

*Humphrey Kerin* m. in 1/2 f.f. *Bridget O'Sullivan* of *Mount, Scartaglen*.  
B(v) They have five boys and two girls.

*Tim Kerin* is m. to *Hannah Sheehan* of *Knockeenalick*. No issue.

*Bridget Kerin* is m. to *Tom Prendeville* of *Braehig*, a farmer. B(v) Issue.

*Jim Kerin* died in U.S.A.

*Mary Kerin* is a Maternity Nurse in *Scartaglen*

*Julia Kerin* now dead was m. to *Arthur O'Brien* of *Knockmanagh*. No issue.

*Ellen James Fleming* (grand d. of *Michael* of *Blarney*) m. a *Mr. Kean* of *Tullig, Castleisland*.

B(iii) Issue: Mary, John, Ellie, Denis, Jim, Peggie, Nano, Maurice and Julia.  
Mary Keane m. Batt Daly of *Lyre, Currow*. Issue:- B(iv) *William, John, Jim, Ellie, Maurice, Nora, Hannah, Batt, Denis and Mary* (10)

*William Daly* went to *Australia* where he m. and had B(v) issue.

*John, Jim and Ellie went to Australia.*

*Maurice Daly is m. in Cork and has B(v) issue.*

*Mary Daly m. a Mr. Hamilton, ex R.I.C. There is B(v) issue.*

*Nora Daly m. a Mr. Ryan another ex R.R.C. B(v) Issue.*

*Hannah Daly m. Michael O'Connor of Knockrour. She died and had had only B(v) one daughter who is m. to a Mr. Cremin of Knockeenahone. B (vi) Issue.*

*Batt Daly m. in ½ his f.f. Miss Clifford of Cloonts, Ballyhar. They have B(v) issue, all young.*

*Denis Daly m. in ½ his f.f. an O'Brien girl from Fieries. B(v) Issue.*

*Catherine, Ellen, Hannah, Margaret, Julia, Marion, Nora, Bridie, Agnes, John, Elizabeth, Maurice and a baby who died (13).*

*Catherine Brosnan m. Mr. P. Cahill. They have B(v) three sons.*

*Ellen Brosnan m. Tom Prendeville of Killarney. Issue: B(v) Eily, Chris, Sheila, Simon, Una, Peg, Cathleen, Thomas, Denis, Jim, Edward, Billie and Mossie. (13)*

*Eily is married to Denis Counihan of High St. There is B(vi) issue.*

*Sheila is married to Mr. Small and has B(vi) issue.*

*Una is a Nun in England.*

*Kathleen m. a Mr. Murray, Killarney.*

*Jim went to Australia.*

*The remainder of the family are unm. (1936)*

*Hannah Brosnan m. a Mr Mappy, No issue.*

*Margaret Brosnan is Mrs. McElligott of C'island. Issue: B(v) 1 boy and 3 girls*

*Julia Brosnan is Mrs. T. Murphy of Castleisland. Issue: B(v) 3 boys and 3 girls.  
One of the boys is a Priest in the Phillipine Island.*

*Marion Brosnan is a Mrs. W. Costelloe of Castleisland. IssueB(v) 3 boys 1 girl.*

*Nora Brosnan is unm and lives at home in Catleisland.*

*Bridie Brosnan is Mrs. Mahony and lives in London. Issue B(v)1 girl.*

*Agnes Brosnan is Mrs. E.Meagher of High St., Killarney. Issue: B(v)5 girls, 1 boy.*



*John Brosnan m. Elizabeth Loughlin of Cordal. B(v) Very large family.*

*Elizabeth Brosnan ???*

*Maurice Brosnan is a Priest in Melbourne.*

*Denis Keane had a Public House in Henn St. Killarney. He m. Mary McCarthy of Incheacullane, Kilcummin, a sister to Johnny McC. Issue: B(iv) Maurice, John, Denis, Tom, Mary, Ellen & Margaret. All the boys went to America.*

*Maurice was N. Teacher.*

*Tim returned from America and he and his sisters are working in the Imperial Hotel, College St., Killarney. The mother sold her house in Henn St. to Mr. David Fleming.*

*Peg Keane m. Dan Lawlor of Ballinhalla, Corda. Dan was brother of Pat Lawlor of Droumadesart, Kilcummin. They had a very large family, about 20 it is said. Most of those children emigrated. One, John, m. in his f.f. a Miss Kearney. probably of Cordal, but had no issue.*

*Jim Keane m. an O'Leary of Castleisland. They to had a B(iv) large family, all of whom emigrated.*

*Nano Keane m. Daniel O'Leary in a f. near Castleisland. They had B(iv) issue all of whom emigrated to New York.*

*Maurice Keane m. a Kerin in her f. at Scartaglen. They had B(iv) children and a father mother and children emigrated to America. Mrs. Kerins's f reverted to a brother.*

*Julia Keane m. a Mr. Twomey near Castleisland. They had issue. B(iv) A son David is a Draper in Castleisland and is m. to a d. of Margaret Brosnan.*

*Nano James Fleming m. John Lombard of Doolaig near Castleisland. Issue: Richard, Aeneas, John, James and Mary. Richard and Aeneas Lombard went to America. John Lombard went to Australia*

*James Lombard m. in his f.f. Catherine Fitzgerald of Cordal. Issue: B(iv) 3 boys and 3 girls.*

*Richard J. Lombard m. in his f.f. an O'Sullivan from Farmers' Bridge. They have B(v) issue - all young.*

*Nano James Lombard m. Con Daly of Ballymacpierce. Issue B(v) - a boy and a girl.*

The four other members of James Lombards's family went to U.S.A.

Mary Lombard m. in ½ her f.f. Denis Reidy of Ballymacelligott. Issue:  
B(iv) Dan and five others.

Dan Denis Reidy m. Mary Fleming, of Cumeenataggil. Issue:- B(v) 2 girls and a  
boy all unm. at home in 1936.

Margaret James Fleming m. James O'Sullivan of Listry. Issue: Ellen and  
Thady.

Ellen O'O'Sullivan m. Denis O'Connor of Southhill, Killarney.  
Issue: B(iv) Denis, Michael, Ellen, Maggie, Mary and Alice.

Denis D. O'Connor became a Carpenter and worked and taught in the  
Killarney School of Industry, founded by Lady Kenmare. Denis died a few  
years ago He was m. to Maggie Fleming of Port Road, Killarney. They had  
issue :B(v) Jack and David both of whom are clerks in the Killarney P.O. They  
are unm.

having one son who afterwards went o America. Pat Herlihy m. again. His  
second wife was Jude Callaghan with whom he had a large family.

C(i) JOHN MICHAEL FLEMING (son of old Michael from Blarney) came a cl. Isteach to Clydine, Kilcummin, and from Currow. Issue: C (ii) (Michael. Michael John Fleming m. Mary Kelly of Gloundeaeugh (Gloundaioch).

Issue: C(iii) John, David, Mike and Mary.

(Old John Michael's wife was a Fleming – family not known)

John Michael Fleming went to Toremore where he got a farm from Brian MacSweeney, a Middleman. He m. Peggy O'Riordan from Rossanean, Currow, and had no issue.

David M. Fleming m. in his father's f. at Clydine, Mary Scannell of Knockalioede, Kilcummin. Issue: C(iii) Minnie, John, Nell, David, Peter, Mick, Nora, Maggie, Julia and Hannah (10)

Minnie D. Fleming m. James Fleming of Clydine. They had a Public House in High St., Killarney. Issue: - Pat, David & Mary. Pat and Mary lived with their aunt Ellen (Nell) at Clydine. Mary went to America. Parents are dead.

John D. Fleming m. in ½ his f.f. at Clydine. He m. Mary o'Connor of Carker. Issue: C(iv) David and Pat both at home an unmarried.

Nell D. Fleming is living in ½ her f.f. at Clydine. She is unm.

David D. Fleming died at home unm.

Peter D. Fleming went to America.

Michael D. Fleming is a Priest in the American Missions.

Nora D. Fleming m. James MacCarthy of Ardagh, Kilcummin. They had three children. Nora died and James MacCarthy was evicted and died after in Killarney. Their children were C(v) Nellie, David and Christie. (have no account of the fate of those children).

Maggie, Julia and Hannah David M. Fleming's three other children went to America.

Mike M. Fleming bought a farm from young Dan MacSweeney at Milleen, was m. to Johanna Daly of Fieries. Issue: C(iv) Mary Julia John, Mike, Pat, Batt., Hannah and Maggie. (8)

Mary M. Fleming m. James O'Neill in his f.f. at Mastergeeha. Issue c(v) two sons one of whom died and the other is at home unm.

Julia M. Fleming m. Tim O'Connor of Matergeeha. No issue.



*John M Fleming* m. in ½ his f.f. *Ellie O'Neill* of Mastergeeha. They had C(v)one daughter *Hannah* and when *Ellie O'Neill* died *John* m. secondly, *Nora Dowling* of *Ballymacelligott*. Issue yes.

*Mike M. Fleming* m. in his uncle *John's* farm at *Toremore*, *Katty Dowling* a sister of his brother *John's* wife. Issue: *Peggie* and *Hannah*, both young.

*Pat M. Fleming* joined the R.I.C. After resigning on pension he m. *Catherine O'Driscoll* of *Clydine*. They bought part of the f. which belonged to *Larry Collins* of *Aghadoe*. No issue.

*Batt M. Fleming* is m. in ½ his f.f. at *Milleen* to *Anne Healy* of *Kilbrean*, *Killarney*. C(v) There is issue.

*Hannah M. Fleming* is m. to a *Mr. Gillard* of *Mayo* – a Creamery Manager. There is no issue.

*Maggie M. Fleming* is m. to *Tom O'Sullivan* of *Matergeeha* in his f.f. There is no issue.

As already stated the sons of *Michael Fleming* of *Blarney* – *David*, *Tom* and *Garret* never came to live in *Kilcummin*. An account of their families would be very interesting in order to complete the genealogical story of a very interesting family. The ancestor of the family came to *Currow* in romantic fashion and it seems a pity that his descendants cannot be fully given the information of the *Fleming* family which according to the tradition from *Blarney* came originally from the townland of *Coolick* in the Parish of *Kilcummin*.
